

Dr. Kubota graduated from Tokyo University in 1981. He was trained as a surgeon at Tokyo University Hospital and Tokyo Metropolitan Police Hospital. He became a senior resident of Second Department of Surgery, University of Tokyo in 1985. After obtaining PhD on experimental pancreas transplantation from Tokyo University, he studied abroad at Department of Transplantation Surgery, Huddinge Hospital, Karolinska Institute for 2 years. He also obtained PhD on cytological diagnosis of liver and pancreas transplantation from Karolinska Institute. He became Associate Professor of Department of Hepato-biliary-pancreatic and Transplantation Surgery, University of Tokyo in 1997. He was elected as Professor and Chairman, Department of Gastro-enterological Surgery, Dokkyo Medical University in 2000. He is now specialized in hepato-biliary-pancreatic surgery including living-donor liver transplantation. Since 2011, he has been vice President of the University Hospital.
