### **Research Profile**

Dr. Kim's clinical and research interests are in gastrointestinal cancers, with specific expertise in carcinoid and neuroendocrine tumors. Dr. Kim is known nationally for her work in translational and epidemiologic approaches in assessing outcomes in patients with these tumors.

### **Clinical Profile**

Dr. Kim has worked closely with Dr. Richard RP Warner (Director of the Center for Carcinoid and Neuroendocrine Tumors) in caring for patients with these uncommon tumors. Together with Dr. Warner, she has collaborated with a multidisciplinary team including oncologists, surgeons, and interventional radiologists. With this clinical expertise, Dr. Kim has developed a regional and national presence. This clinical expertise is complemented by her research interests in outcomes of these understudied patients.

Dr. Kim has also become regionally and nationally known for her expertise as an endosonographer. She has served on committees in the AGA and ASGE, helping to develop program content and review abstracts for these national meetings. Dr. Kim has also developed leadership skills as President of the NYSGE (New York Society for Gastrointestinal Endoscopy), the largest regional endoscopic organization in the US. This position has involved leadership of a 20-member Executive Council, strategic and financial planning, and overseeing of the NYSGE Annual Course (with the largest attendance after DDW and ACG).

### **Impact**

As evidenced by her multiple teaching awards, Dr. Kim has taught and mentored dozens of medical students, residents, and gastroenterology fellows. Many of her students have successfully published manuscripts under her supervision and have become junior faculty at other academic institutions.
