1. RESEARCH STATEMENTS

Research Summary.

The primary goal of my research is to improve the surgical care that cancer patients receive, with research activity centered around three major foci: gastric cancer, colorectal cancer, and quality improvement initiatives. The major techniques utilized in my research are assessment of outcomes through examination of administrative databases, such as those at the Institute of Clinical Evaluative Sciences (ICES) and the Surveillance Epidemiology and End Results (SEER) database in the United States. Following evaluation of patient outcomes, I have engaged knowledge translation researchers to examine the gaps in physician knowledge that result in gaps in patient care, so that the quality of patient care can be improved by providing physicians with training to reduce the gaps in their knowledge.
